Dear Partner in Christ,

God showed up this month from the prayer needs that we communicated to you in our April Prayer Letter. Thanks so much for your prayers. Our focus was for a well to be drilled at Koko Children's Village in Liberia and for missionaries to serve within AICM here and in Liberia. God has already provided the \$2,750 needed plus more for the well project.

Five days after the mailing of the letters, one evening, we received a call from Pastor Sherry Colby of Victory Worship Center that a member of the church gave \$1,000 for the children and the church had decided to add \$500 to the amount. "We will send a check of \$1,500 shortly," Pastor Colby said. We joyfully thanked her for their decision to bless the children. Two days later, Pastor Colby called us with an exuberant tone: "Pastor Liberty, I am on my way to Church, but I needed to tell you this before leaving. I met a check of additional \$2,600 from another member of the church for the well project!!" Immediately I yielded, Praise God; and called my wife, Esther to tell her that God had performed another miracle. Total funds we received for the project is \$4,600. The Lord is so good! The extra funds will be used for the children's food and tuitions for those who have no sponsors.

Now keep praying for God to raise up missionaries from the West to serve in Liberia, West Africa with our ministries in that Country. Pray also for two missionaries to join our office staff at Boynton Beach, Florida.

Our focus in this issue is AICM Scholarship Program in Liberia. This ministry raises funds yearly to keep the needed children in Liberia in school. As you may know, the unemployment rate in Liberia is 85% as a result of the many years of civil conflict. The war is over; Liberia now has a constituted government. President Ellen Johnson-Sirleaf of Liberia is the first female president on the Continent of Africa. She is working tirelessly in the reconstruction process of the country. Though she is doing a wonderful job, it has not been easy. AICM involvement in the reconstruction of Liberia is by providing scholarship to needed students. With the support of our partners and friends, we are sponsoring 100 students on AICM scholarship in Liberia. The cost of one student per semester is just \$50. We are preparing for their next academic year 2009-2010 which will begin in July this year. Pray with us so that the Lord will provide \$5,000 to pay their tuition for the first semester as required by the school. The Semester registration will commence during the first week of July 2009. Meanwhile, we thank those that have been supporting students in Liberia through AICM.
